

03. REGISTRATION AND VISA FEE

\$1100 USD fee covers student visa processing and seat reservation. Kindly be advised that this fee is non-refundable.

04. ELIGIBILITY

Begin your journey to becoming a pilot by evaluating your eligibility through our online form.

05. PREPARING FOR YOUR ARRIVAL

Get ready for your journey! We'll provide guidance and support to ensure a smooth transition before you arrive.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Valid Passport for the duration of the program
- Demonstrate financial resources for living expenses (\$20,000 CAD).
- Demonstrate financial resources for tuition fee.
- Original education transcripts (Translated in english).

DGCA CPL REQUIREMENTS

Knowledge Exams:

- Air Regulations
- Air Navigation
- Meteorology
- Technical General
- Radio Telephony Restricted (Aeronautical RTR-A)

Educational Qualifications:

- General 10 + 2 : Physics and Mathematics
- Required for SPL / PPL to CPL Conversion, or Direct Entry

Age Requirement

- Minimum 18 Years of Age

Language Proficiency

- Minimum English (ELP Lvl 4).

Medical Requirement

- Class 1 medical certificate (initial and renewal)

POST - GRADUATION WORK PERMIT

A post-graduation work permit (PGWP) is an open work permit that allows international graduates to live and work in Canada for a designated period of up to three years.

If you've completed the 2 year program at **CFI Flight Academy**, you could qualify for a post-graduation work permit (PGWP), granting you the freedom to work for any employer. To apply, ensure you submit your application within 90 days of finishing your program, holding a valid study permit at the time of application.
